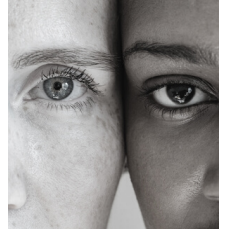




OVERCOMING RACIAL PREJUDICE
